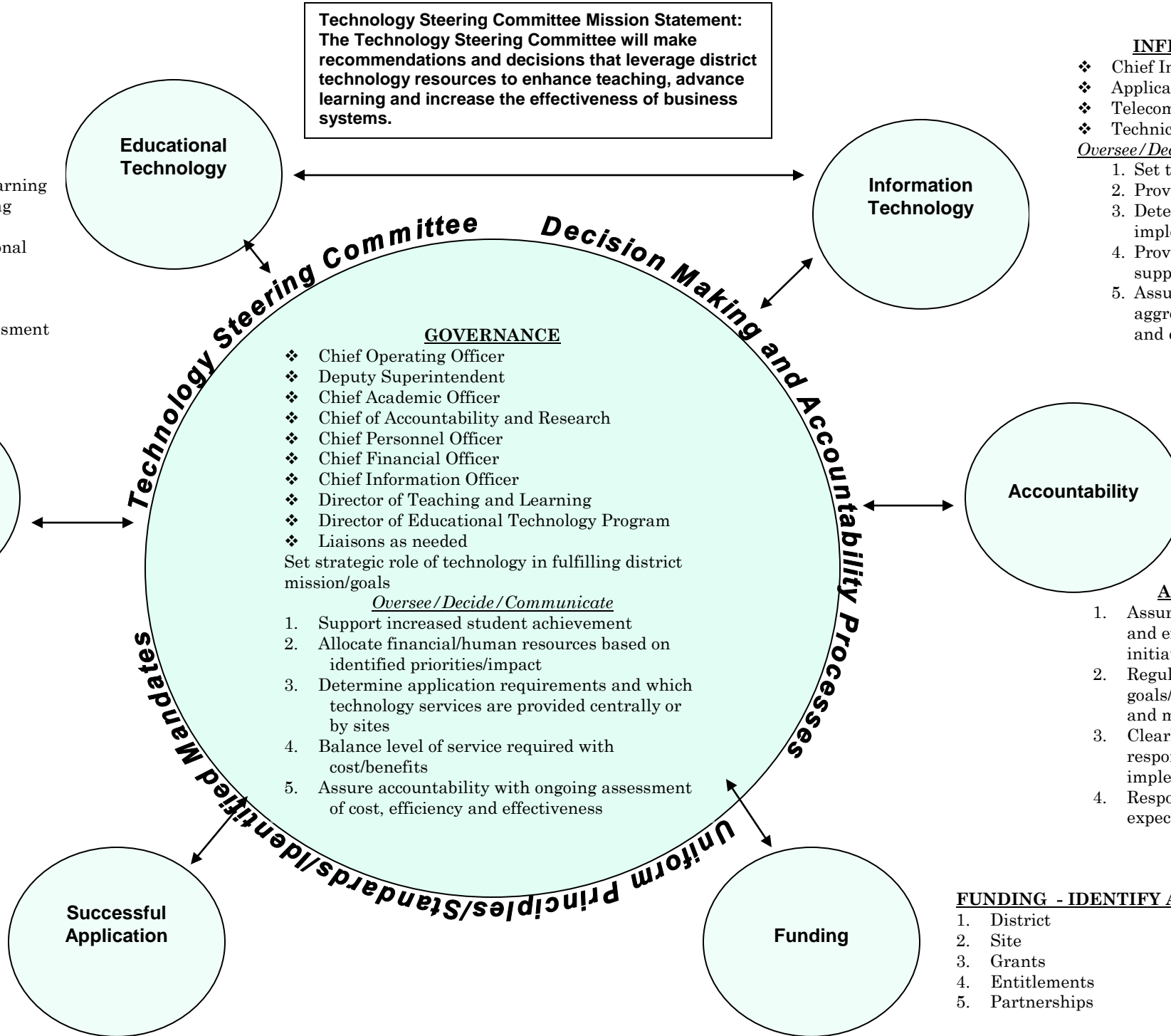

5. Assure accountability with ongoing assessment of cost, efficiency and effectiveness

**ACCOUNTABILITY**

2. Regularly evaluate technology goals/objectives/resources/services and make adjustments as needed
